(Working around outer edge, ch 6 at end of last row worked on diagram dc in same st, *(ch 1,skip next row, dc in end of next row) across to next corner st, ch 1, dc ch 3 dc in corner st, ch 1 skip next st dc in nect st across to next corner st ch 1 dc ch 3 dc in corner st repeat around to last st dc in last st join with sl st in 3 rd ch of ch 6) (DO NT RURN) Fasten off.
