

Edging for Tigger blanket by Corinna Alexander.

(Working around outer edge, ch 6 at end of last row worked on diagram dc in same st, *(ch 1, skip next row, dc in end of next row) across to next corner st, ch 1, dc ch 3 dc in corner st, ch 1 skip next st dc in next st across to next corner st ch 1 dc ch 3 dc in corner st repeat around to last st dc in last st join with sl st in 3rd ch of ch 6) (DO NOT TURN) Fasten off. (Rnd 2) Join white with sc in any corner ch 3 sp, ch 3 sc in same st sc in each st and ch 1 sp with (sc ch 3 sc in each corner st join with a sl st to first sc (Rnd 3) ch 1 sc in first st, ch 1 sc ch 3 sc in next ch 3 sp ch 1 skip next st sc in next st ch 1 skip next st round whsch 3 sc in each ch 3 sp join (TURN) (Rnd 4 - 10) ch 1 skip first st sc in first ch 1 sp ch 1 skip next st sc in next ch 1 sp across to next corner ch 3 sp ch 1 sc ch 3 sc in corner st repeat to end join (fasten off white at end of row 10)(Rnd 11) join lt blue or chosen color with a sl st in any corner ch 3 sp ch 6 dc in same sp ch 1 { *skip next st dc in next ch 1 sp ch 1 across to next corner ch 3 sp dc ch 3 dc in corner st* } repeat Between { ** } join (DO NOT TURN) (Rnds 12-21) with lt blue or chosen color working in established pattern repeat rnds 2 -11 fasten off at end of last rnd, (Rnd 22) Repeat rnd 2 fasten off (Rnd 23) join lt blue or chosen color with sc in any st sc in each st around with 3 sc in each corner ch 3 sp fasten off weave in all ends.)
